



## **Prof Yi-Wen LIN**

Yi-Wen Lin is an associate Professor in School of Post-Baccalaureate Chinese Medicine, College of Chinese Medicine, China medical University, and the Deputy Director of Research Center for Chinese Medicine and Acupuncture, Ministry of Education. He is also a visiting professor in the Kyung-Hee University of Korean Medicine in the past 2 years. Prof Lin has finished his Ph.D. degree in the Institute of Physiology at National Yang-Ming University in from 2002-2004. He also finished his postdoctoral fellow in the Institute of Biomedical Science (IBMS) at Academia Sinica in 2009. Prof. Lin has investigated acupuncture science and Chinese herbal medicine for 10 years. He is the principal investigator and co-investigator of several National grants, especially in preclinical animal studies in acupuncture. He topics are always focus on acupuncture science including Acupuncture analgesia, Acupuncture for body weight control, Acupuncture for stroke, Acupuncture for epilepsy treatments, acupoints microenvironment, and meridian research. He has several techniques for Acupuncture research such as animal behavior, western blot, immunostaining, in vitro electrophysiology, in vivo electrophysiology, optogenetics, etc. He has published over 50 peer-reviewed SCI papers, over 30 grants, 40 conferences, and 3 patents. Prof Lin serves as editors and reviewers for over 50 SCI journals.
