



Dr CHANG, Raymond Chuen Chung

Dr. Chang is an Associate Professor in the School of Biomedical Sciences, Investigator and Coordinator of Research Centre of Heart, Brain, Hormone and Healthy Aging, Member of The State Key Laboratory of Brain and Cognitive Sciences. Dr. Chang is also the Founder and Secretary of HKU Alzheimer's Disease Research Network.

Dr. Chang received a research scholarship by German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) to pursue his doctoral training in neurophysiology and clinical neuroscience at the University of Munich, Munich, Germany. Afterwards, he continued his postdoctoral training in neuropharmacology and molecular neuroscience at National Institute of Environmental Health, National Institutes of Health, USA. He then moved to The University of Hong Kong focusing on Natural products and neurodegeneration in Alzheimer's disease. He has published over 100 peer-reviewed papers and 13 book chapters in neurodegeneration, neuroimmunology and drug discovery in these areas. His *h*-index is 35 from Google Scholar and 29 from Scopus. He is also an editor for two books on neurodegenerative diseases and one new book on 'Lycium barbarum and Health'. Dr. Chang is now the Scientific Advisory Board member in International Alzheimer's / Parkinson's diseases Symposium, Scientific Review Committee for Alzheimer Association in USA. He is the handling associate editor in Journal of Alzheimer's Disease, and Section Chief Editor for Journal of Neuroimmune Pharmacology for the section of Natural Medicine. He is also a member of editorial board of more than 20 different journals. He is also a grant reviewer for many different grant agencies/foundations, including Research Grant Council (HK), MRC (UK), and Alzheimer's Association (USA).
