He was dispatched to Japan university to study psychological medicine by the Ministry of Health of the People's Republic of China in 1994. He composed 2 monographs: outline of psychological recovery and Japanese-Chinese-English medical words dictionary about psychological medicine. He also

published more than 10 essays in journals of national or province level. “The prevention and control technology of post-traumatic stress disorder with combination of traditional Chinese and western medicine” is awarded in prevention and control technology of the major and high incidence disease in 2014 supported by Science Technology Department of Zhejiang province. The Chinese medicine study on “the treatment of Obsessive Compulsive Disorder by transcutaneous electrical acupoint stimulation” is supported by Ministry of Science and Technology of the People’s Republic of China, which in June 2007, won the second prize of Zhejiang Chinese Medicine science and technology innovation award and in 2006, won the third prize of science and technology award of Zhejiang province.
