



Professor Tong Yao (童瑤)

Professor Tong Yao is currently serving as Vice Chairman of Expert Committee, Advisor of Development Center of Teachers, Chief Advisor of Overseas Networking and Education of International Education College at Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SUTCM). In addition, she is also an Honorary Professor of the School of Chinese Medicine (SCM), the University of Hong Kong (HKU) after having served as the Chair Professor and Director of the SCM from 2004 to 2012. Before joining HKU, she was the former Professor, Vice President of the SUTCM, Vice President of the Shanghai Academy of Traditional Chinese Medicine from 1998 to 2003 as well as the Dean of the School of Basic Medical Sciences, SUTCM from 1995 to 1998.

Professor Tong has been engaged in teaching, in particular the basic theories and Gynaecology of Chinese Medicine, research and clinical practice for 38 years. Her clinical specialties focus on psychosomatic disorders and gynaecological illnesses while her research interests include Study on High Education of Chinese Medicine, Literature study on comparison of Chinese Medicine with Western Medicine, Clinical trial and mechanism research on menopausal syndrome in TCM therapy, mechanism and clinical research on cancer in TCM therapy. She was involved in more than 40 presentations in International Conference for Chinese medicine research projects. She has also published 132 papers (including 70 SCI papers), 3 international patents and 31 books.
