



Dr SCHRÓDER, Sven

Dr med. Sven Schröder (born 1962 in Hamburg) completed his training as a specialist in neurology in Berlin and Hamburg, primarily at the University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf (UKE). From 2000 on, he was in charge of one of the largest TCM practices in Hamburg. He received his TCM training in acupuncture, medicinal herbal therapy and tuiná in Germany and China. Schröder is a lecturer for the master's degree course of studies in TCM at the University of Porto. He chairs the Quality Circle for Acupuncture and TCM of the Hamburg Medical Chamber. He has an authorization for postgraduate medical education in acupuncture and neurology from the Hamburg Medical Chamber. In 2010 he became founding medical director of the new HanseMercur Center for Traditional Chinese Medicine at the University Medical Center Hamburg Eppendorf. Since 2011 he is the chairman of the german committee and delegation in the ISO process for the standardization of Chinese medicine (ISO-TC-249) and the convener of the working group safety and quality of Chinese herbs. His own research work focuses on neuroprotective and neuroregenerative effects of TCM.
