Professor Shi Qi (施杞教授) is an internationally renowned authority in TCM Traumatology and Orthopedics. After graduation at the Shanghai University of TCM, he joined his alma mater and became a specialist in Traumatology and Orthopedic research. He had extensive research in the university-affiliated hospitals and worked his way all the way up in the academic hierarchy, and ultimately became the President of the Shanghai University of TCM in 1993.

After retiring from his term of Presidency of the Shanghai University in 1998 he remains active in his research and clinical services in the Shanghai University of TCM, and continues to serve as a "National PhD supervisor" and carries the title of "Chief Physician" and "Shanghai's Celebrated TCM Doctor". He has extensive research collaborations both nationally and internationally, including collaboration with the Orthopedic Department of The University of Hong Kong.

He is currently President of the Shanghai Association of TCM, President of the China Association of TCM Traumatology and Orthopaedic, Vice-President of the China Association of TCM, Member of the Committee of Chinese Pharmacopoeia, Member of Committee of Drug Evaluation, PRC, Vice-Chairman of Higher Medical Education Association of China, Member of Shanghai People's Political Consultative Conference, Vice-President of Shanghai TCM Society, Member of Shanghai Academic Degree Committee, Member of Shanghai's Consultative Committee of TCM Affairs, and Chairman of Higher TCM Education Association of China.
