Her research in Chinese Medicine (CM) started with a RCT on the effectiveness of acupuncture in induction of labor in the 1970s. It was revived with work on the effect of qigong in cancer, diabetes and hypertension and the use of Tai Chi to prevent fall in elderly. With wide research interest from perinatology, haematology to hepatitis B, she has been on editorial boards of 6 journals, and has published 89 papers and co-edited a book “Challenges of SARS”. As Advisor in Integrative Medicine, she is now steering research, education and knowledge transfer to support collaboration among CM and western medicine practitioners.
